What Is It?

Credit cards, banking info, loan info, and Social Security numbers are all at risk. When PC Eraser™ is used instead of the delete function, recovering your personal files becomes virtually impossible.

Minimum Requirements

- Windows 98SE, ME, 2000, XP, or Vista 32
- Processor: 90 Mhz or above
- Memory:
 - 64 MB or higher for Windows 98/ME.
 - 128 MB or higher for Windows 2000/XP/Vista 32
- FAT, FAT32 or NTFS formatted hard drive.
- Requires 16 MB available hard drive space or better.

How Does It Work?

- Select files to be erased.
- Click Destroy Now.
- Files are removed using US Gov't Department of Defense standards.
- PC Eraser's Scrub Free Space function removes traces of files that can be found in unallocated sections of the hard drive.
- Allows you to donate, sell or properly dispose of your old computer.
